

## Business & Technology Program: Agribusiness Management Concentration

Why should I major in Agribusiness? The Agribusiness Program is designed to provide a general understanding of business principles as they relate to the agricultural industry. The entire Business and Technology Program is accredited by the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE). Accreditation of the Business and Technology Program means that the courses, concentrations and majors are ranked as quality courses and programs by an outside over-sight group, and that the academic business program is functioning effectively (e.g., excellent student learning outcomes). Students in this cooperative program will attend Iowa Western Community College in Council Bluffs, Iowa for a portion of their coursework.

What type of degree will I earn at Grace University if I enroll in this program? Graduates of the Business Administration Program will earn a Bachelor of Science degree.

What kind of jobs would be available to me after I graduate from Grace University with this major? This degree prepares graduates for careers in agribusiness, farm management, and production agriculture as well as domestic and international agriculture and ag-related sales, service, and supply industries.
