

Business & Technology Program: Intercultural Administration Concentration

Why should I major in Intercultural Administration? The Intercultural Administration program provides students with a broad foundation in business coupled with an understanding of intercultural issues. This degree is earned partially through a study overseas program called The Edge. The entire Business and Technology Program is accredited by the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE). Accreditation of the Business and Technology Program means that the courses, concentrations and majors are ranked as quality courses and programs by an outside over-sight group, and that the academic business program is functioning effectively (e.g., excellent student learning outcomes).

What type of degree will I earn at Grace University if I enroll in this program? Graduates of the Intercultural Administration Program will earn a Bachelor of Science degree.

What kind of jobs would be available to me after I graduate from Grace University with this major? This degree is designed for the student who desires to be engaged in “tent-making” missionary service or be support staff for an intercultural missions organization.
