

BS 306CC/ BS 306DC - Daniel & Revelation SYLLABUS

3 Hour or 4 Hour Course

Description

Through a study of Daniel, Revelation and the Thessalonian letters, the course is designed to establish the premillennial framework for biblical prophecy.

Objectives

By taking this course the student will:

1. Grasp the prophetic significance of the books studied as they relate to premillennial and dispensational hermeneutics.
2. Develop Bible study and bibliographic skills to better handle interpretive issues within the text.
3. Understand the nature and sequence of prophecy, both fulfilled and unfulfilled, from the books studied.
4. Demonstrate research and communication skills through written projects.
