Application Instructions

1. Complete the *Application for Admission* form.

- Print legibly in ink and answer all questions thoroughly and completely.
- Include the application fee. (\$20 on line, \$35 hard copy)
- Mail to the GU Admissions Office.

2. Submit a writing sample for evaluation.

- The writing sample is used for placement purposes in our English courses. Therefore, it should be a representation of your best skills as a writer.
- More instructions are available from your admissions counselor.
- ***The writing sample is waived*** for students who have achieved an ACT English score of 18 or an SAT Critical Reading score of 450.

3. Request official transcripts.

- Official transcripts are required from all the institutions (High School/Colleges) you have attended.
- Have transcripts mailed to the Admissions Office at Grace University.

4. Submit an ACT (preferred) or SAT test score.

- If you have not yet taken either test, you can register for the next available test date through your high school guidance counselor or online at www.actstudent.org.
- Grace University's minimum requirement for the ACT is a composite score of 20. The minimum requirement for the SAT is a 940 total.
- Grace University's ACT code is 2454. Grace University's SAT code is 6248.
- Students over age 25 will be asked to submit a writing sample for evaluation if no ACT or SAT test scores are available. See instruction #2 for more details.

5. Mark these deadlines on your calendar!

- If you complete the *Application for Admission*, the *Grace University Financial Aid Application* and the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) by April 1st, you will have priority consideration for federal and or state aid.
- Applications received after April 1st may receive limited federal, state or institutional aid.
- Grace University's FAFSA identification number is 002547.

6. Transfer students

- Transfer students are required to complete and submit all forms required of first time college applicants.
- In addition to the required forms, transfer students are required to submit official transcripts from each college previously attended.
